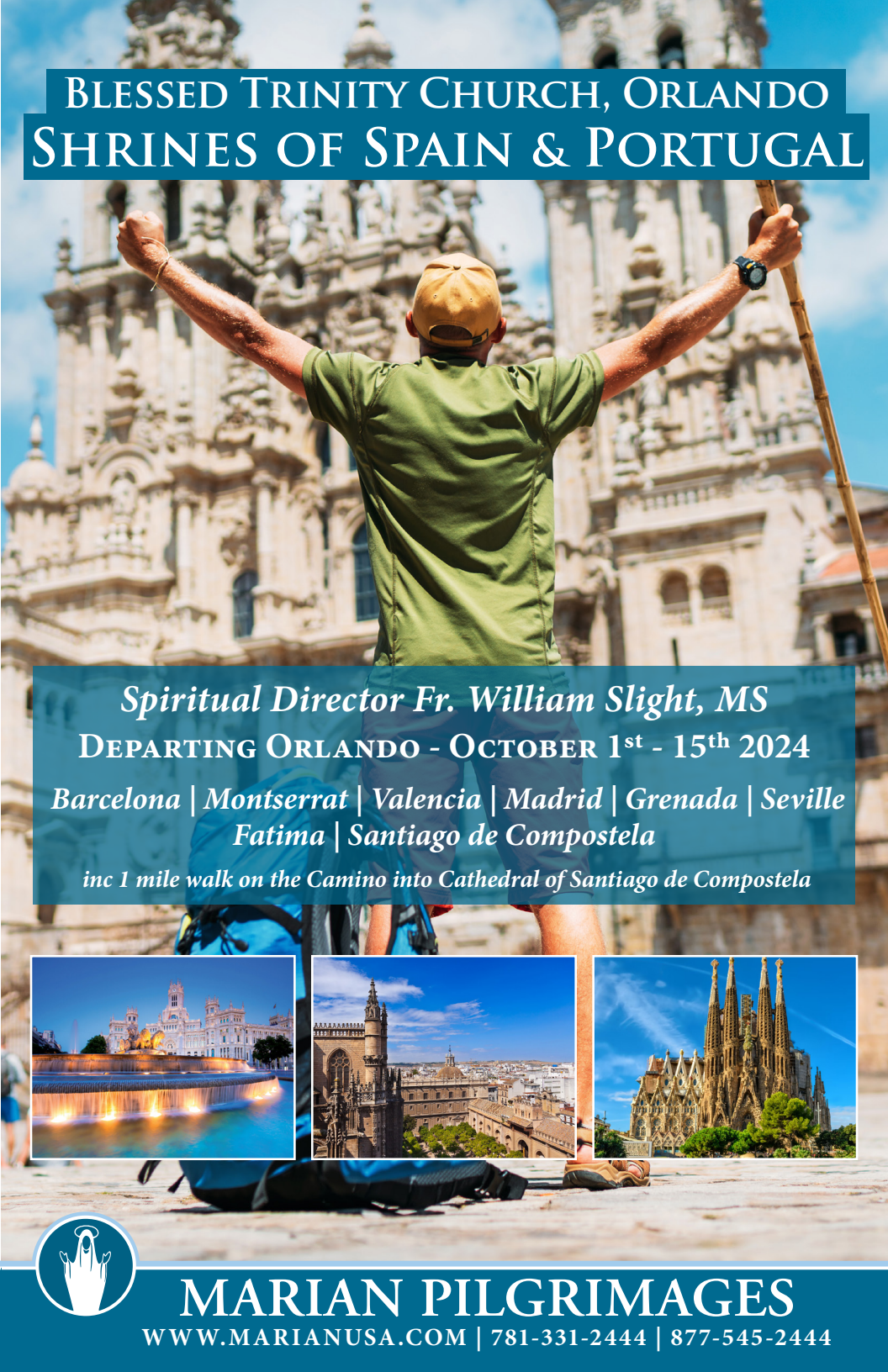

Day 1 – Tuesday, October 1

Today we embark on our journey to the lands of Christian history with an overnight flight to Spain. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience. Get some rest on the flight. Tomorrow you will be walking where the apostles walked!

Day 2 – Wednesday, October 2

Barcelona city half day morning tour including the Sagrada Familia & Gothic Quarter. Lunch in local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit to Santa Maria de Montserrat, an abbey of the Order of Saint Benedict located on the mountain of Montserrat. Return to your hotel in Barcelona for evening dinner.

Day 3 – Thursday, October 3

After breakfast we depart from Barcelona to Valencia. Arrival in the afternoon to the Hotel Catalonia Excelsior before a visit to Valencia city including the Cathedral where history meets art, a sanctuary for treasures such as the High Altar's Renaissance frescoes (rediscovered in 2004 after remaining hidden for centuries behind a dome), and what many believe is the Holy Chalice from which Jesus Christ drank during the Last Supper.

Day 4 – Friday, October 4

Depart from Valencia to Madrid after breakfast, arriving in the city of Madrid in the early afternoon. Check-in to the 4 star Hotel NH Ribera del Manzanares for 2 nights. In the afternoon we visit The Cathedral of Saint Mary the Royal of the Almudena, commonly known as the Almudena Cathedral for short. This Roman Catholic cathedral in Madrid, the capital city of Spain is the seat of the Archdiocese of Madrid before returning to the hotel for dinner and free time.

Day 5 – Saturday, October 5

In the morning we visit Valle de los Caídos and Escorial on the outskirts of Madrid. The Valley of Cuelgamuros, formerly known as Valley of the Fallen, is a monument in the Sierra de Guadarrama, near Madrid. The valley contains a Catholic Basilica and a

monumental memorial in the municipality of San Lorenzo de El Escorial. Visit to Museum El Prado with some free time in Madrid.

Day 6 – Sunday, October 6

In the morning we transfer to Toledo, stop, and visit the city including cathedral of Toledo. As one of the most visited tourist attractions in Toledo, the cathedral is well-known for its magnificent medieval Gothic architecture, as well as the famous artwork inside. Check-in to the 4 star hotel Zentral Mayoral for overnight stay.

Day 7 – Monday, October 7

Transfer to Granada. Arrival in the afternoon in 4 star hotel Occidental Granada for 2 nights. Visit The Alhambra is a palace and fortress complex located in Granada, Andalusia, Spain. It is one of the most famous monuments of Islamic architecture and one of the best-preserved palaces of the historic Islamic world, in addition to containing notable examples of Spanish Renaissance architecture before returning to hotel for dinner.

Day 8 – Tuesday, October 8

Visit to the city of Granada, including Cathedral and Royal Chapel in the morning. The cathedral of Granada is dedicated to the Virgin of the Incarnation. This grand 16th century church largely dates back to the Renaissance and is 375 feet long and 220 feet wide. The Capilla Real, the Royal burial chapel, abuts the cathedral and can be visited separately. Afternoon for a walking visit of the Albaicin, the Old Quarter of Granada.

Day 9 – Wednesday, October 9

After breakfast we Transfer to Sevilla. Arrival mid-morning and check-in to the 4 star HH Plaza de Armas for 2 nights. After check-in we will take a tour of the city including the Cathedral, Giralda and Alcazar in the afternoon. The Cathedral of Saint Mary of the See, better known as Seville Cathedral, is a Roman Catholic cathedral in Seville, Andalusia, Spain. It was registered in 1987 by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, along with

the adjoining Alcázar palace complex and the General Archive of the Indies.

Day 10 – Thursday, October 10

Morning excursion to Cordoba city Córdoba is famous around the world for its Great Mosque. Its historic old town is a World Heritage site, full of little streets to be explored, courtyards full of flowers, inviting squares and lively taverns where you can enjoy a good flamenco performance or try the local cuisine. Including visits to the Mosque of Coroba and Alcazes. Free time in Seville in the afternoon.

Day 11 – Friday, October 11

Transfer to Fatima. Arrive afternoon and check-in to the 4 star Hotel Styler. After some relaxing time our guide will take us on a tour of the sanctuary which will include visits to the following places: Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary - It was barely a decade after the apparitions that construction began on this church with its stirring Neo-Baroque architecture. It is now home to the tombs of the shepherd children. Chapel of the Apparitions - considered as “the heart” of the Marian Shrine and where the Virgin Mary appeared in 1917. Basilica of the Most Holy Trinity - built to accommodate the growing number of pilgrims arriving in Fatima. The basilica can accommodate more than 8,000 pilgrims and boasts some magnificent works of liturgical art.

Day 12 – Saturday, October 12

Day in Fatima. This morning we will visit the sites associated with the apparitions and three shepherd children. Lapa do Cabeço - As the site of the first and third apparitions of the Angel of Peace to the children of Fatima, Lapa do Cabeço is a true place of reflection and prayer. Valinhos - Between the 8th and 9th station of the Way of the Cross in the Path of the little Shepherds, there is the place where the fourth apparition of Our Lady took place, on August 19th, 1917. Aljustrel - Here we will see the late 19th century family houses of the children. In the backyard of Lucia's house, we

will see the famous well associated with the second apparition of the Angel, in the summer of 1916. Church of St. Stephen - Our morning will end at the Hungarian Calvary where we will celebrate Mass in the church dedicated St. Stephen, King of Hungary. We will enjoy an afternoon at leisure and after dinner attend the Candlelight Procession and Rosary which take place each evening at 9 pm in the sanctuary.

Day 13 – Sunday, October 13

Transfer to Santiago stopping in Braga on the way to visit the Sanctuary of Bom Jesus do Monte. Arriving in Santiago de Compostela in late afternoon. Check-in to the 4 star Hotel Monumento San Francisco. Visit to Cathedral and Old Town in the evening.

Day 14 – Monday, October 14

This morning we will walk the last mile of the Camino de Santiago in the Spirit of St. James into Santiago to attend the Pilgrim mass and visit the many churches and museums. The Santiago de Compostela cathedral Basilica is part of the Metropolitan Archdiocese of Santiago de Compostela and is an integral component of the Santiago de Compostela World Heritage Site in Galicia, Spain. The cathedral is the reputed burial place of Saint James the Great, one of the apostles of Jesus Christ.

Day 15 – Tuesday, October 15

Morning transfer to Porto for flight home filled with the Peace and Hope of St James, and a sense of tranquility, rejuvenation, and gratitude in our hearts.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS: Passengers are responsible for ensuring that they have the proper travel documents and MUST CHECK with the respective consulate(s) or visa agency to determine whether any visas or passports are required. Passports are required to be valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. Some countries require a full blank page in the passport for stamping purposes.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: For your protection, we strongly recommend that you purchase trip cancellation and travel accident insurance. However, no representation or description of the insurance made by Marian Pilgrimages USA to you, constitutes a binding assurance or promise about the insurance. If you decline travel insurance you will be required to accept a disclaimer. Marian Pilgrimages USA is not an insurance company and has no responsibility for the submission, payment or adjustment of any insurance claims. Any claims that may fall under the relevant travel insurance policy must be submitted to the insurance company identified in the policy.

PRICES: Prices are per person based upon double occupancy. Prices do not include items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, water, beverages, food other than the table d'hotel menu, passport and visa fees, insurance unless specifically indicated in the package inclusions. Prices are correct at time of publication; Group prices and prices stated on Pilgrimage brochures are set for a pre-defined number of passengers. Additional bookings to this pre-defined number are subject to a different price, as airfares continually fluctuate and classes of service may have limited capacity. All prices are subject to substantial increases in oil prices and currency exchange. In case of human or computer error, Marian Pilgrimages USA reserves the right to re-invoice for the correct price or service. A full refund will be made to passengers who choose not to pay an increase, provided Marian Pilgrimages USA receives a written cancellation within five days of the price increase notification.

PAYMENT & CANCELLATION:

Deposit: A Deposit is required at time of reservation. Deposits will be defined on the Pilgrimage brochure, online or on the reservation form and may differ depending on the pilgrimage.
Special Events & Products Deposit, Final Payment, and Cancellation fees may differ for special events, tours with internal flights, select hotels and tour packages and will be advised at time of booking.

Payment Schedule: 90 days prior to departure - 50% of full cost due
60 days prior to departure - Balance due

Late Payment: All travel services will be subject to automatic cancellation if not paid by due dates above.

Form of Payment: US Dollar check, bank check, money order, wire transfer, major credit cards or debit cards. Credit card charges will be accepted by phone or online. Final payment will be processed upon submission of a completed Marian Pilgrimages USA Reservation Form or online. All payments made within 30 days of departure must be in the form of a certified check, money order, or credit or debit card; certified checks and money orders should be delivered to Marian Pilgrimages USA no later than 3 days following the reservation. There is a \$50 fee for returned checks.

Cancellation: Once a partial or full payment has been made, cancellations will only be accepted in writing. If you do not receive an acknowledgment within 48 hours, call 877-545-2444 to ensure your information was received.

Cancellation charges are applied based on the date that the written cancellation is received.

Group Tour Airfare & Instant Purchase Airfare are non-refundable once purchased, usually 8-12 weeks before departure. This also applies to any airfare once tickets are issued.

Reservation Changes: Changes to an existing reservation, whatever the cause, will incur a \$50 per person charge plus any additional supplier fees. This includes name changes. TRAVELERS WITH DISABILITIES:

Tour participants requiring any form of assistance are required to notify Marian Pilgrimages USA in writing prior to reservation for review and our agreement. Additionally the tour participant, must be accompanied by an individual responsible for providing those services. Tour managers, guides, drivers or other tour, hotel, ship personnel are not able to provide such assistance. Escorted tours are fast-paced, often requiring lengthy walks over uneven terrain. Clients with special needs may be better served independently. Marian Pilgrimages USA can suggest touring options based upon specific requirements. In order to participate in escorted tours, passengers must be able to understand and follow instructions given by the Tour Director at all times. Passengers may not interfere actively or passively with the successful operation of the tour, including but not limited to emergency situations.

Wheelchairs & Walkers:

Hotels and cruises outside of the United States are not required to comply with ADA requirements and therefore may not have ramps, wide entryways or elevators to accommodate disabled passengers or devices such as wheelchairs, walkers and motorized scooters. Due to physical constraints and space limitations, wheelchairs, walkers and motorized scooters may not be taken aboard motor coaches.

Service Animals: Service animals cannot be accommodated on international escorted tours.

Marian Pilgrimages USA reserves the right to remove any person from a tour who has not provided the required notification, has not received written confirmation from Marian Pilgrimages USA, or does not comply with these regulations. All related expenses, including those to return home, will be borne by the passenger.

AIRLINES: Marian Pilgrimages USA offers a choice of airlines and airfares for your convenience, but is not responsible for the services and policies imposed by the airline selected. Airline schedules and flights are subject to change without notice.

Airline Tickets: Once full payment is received, Marian Pilgrimages USA airline tickets will be issued and are fully non-refundable. Should airline tickets require to be issued earlier than the Final Payment Due date, you may be required to pay a larger non-refundable deposit and/or complete full payment. Once issued, Published Instant Purchase Airfare tickets normally may be changed prior to the departure date and the airfare applied toward travel within 12 months of the original date of issue for a fee of \$200 plus any difference in airfare; specific fees and policies may vary by airline.

Airline Seat Assignments: As a courtesy service, airline seat assignments are requested on your behalf. Assignments reflect the best available seats at the time of booking. Airline Frequent Flier Programs: Passengers are responsible to contact their airline directly regarding mileage eligibility and accrual. Airline frequent flier programs determine whether to award miles in part or total based on their own rules which are updated frequently. Some discounted or promotional airfares as well as some code-share flights are not eligible for mileage accrual. Not all published airfares are eligible for mileage. Marian Pilgrimages USA Travel will record frequent flier numbers when provided by the passenger prior to travel documents being issued. However, the addition of frequent flier numbers to airline records does not guarantee mileage eligibility which is at the sole discretion of each airline. Airline schedule changes may result in flights which were originally eligible for mileage accrual no longer being eligible. We highly recommend passengers to provide their frequent flier account information whenever checking in on-line and/or at the airport check-in desk. After travel has commenced, it is often not possible to apply for frequent mileage credit. Passengers are also responsible to determine whether previously earned mileage may be applied to flights to secure upgrades.

Contact Information: Pursuant to TSA Secure Flight requirements, passengers are responsible to provide Marian Pilgrimages USA with their name as it appears on their passport (or other government-issued I.D. when traveling), date of birth, gender, address, phone number, email for all passengers. Passengers must ensure that names are correctly listed on their invoice. Marian Pilgrimages USA will not be responsible for passengers who do not receive an invoice or documents or are denied boarding due to inaccurate information.

Airline Taxes & Fuel Surcharges: If you purchased airfare, airline taxes and fuel surcharges are included. Prior to completion of full payment there is a potential for a price increase(s) due to increases in government-levied taxes and fees and/or fuel surcharges.

Schedule Changes: In the event of an airline schedule change, Marian Pilgrimages USA will make every effort to inform passengers of the schedule change and new flight schedule prior to departure. Marian Pilgrimages USA is not responsible for schedule changes including, when applicable,

changes in routing and/or the number of stops in the itinerary. Marian Pilgrimages USA is unable to provide compensation for schedule changes, seat assignment modifications, or cancellations implemented by an airline. In the event of any change in flight itinerary made directly between passengers and their airline, it is the passengers' responsibility to advise Marian Pilgrimages USA of amended flight details in writing to info@marianUSA.com. Marian Pilgrimages USA cannot be held responsible for land services, including arrival and/or departure transfers, if flights are changed without its knowledge.

Hotel Accommodations: All rooms are standard twin-bedded (two single beds) or one double bed rooms with private facilities, unless you have specifically requested and paid for an upgraded room category. Special requests such as bed types, smoking preference and connecting rooms are subject to availability. Room selection in all cases, unless otherwise reserved, is strictly at the discretion of the hotel's management on a run-of-house basis. Some single rooms are smaller than a standard room size. The number of persons accommodated does not dictate the room size. Although available at most 4 and 5 star hotels, use of air-conditioning abroad differs greatly from the United States. Transfers: Transfers are provided as indicated for each tour by car, minibus, or motor coach provided. If you purchase a land-only tour, your transfer is included or if you deviate from the arrival and/or departure dates as stated in the itinerary, you will have the option to add transfer services.

Itinerary: Will be operated by motor-vehicle, its size dictated by the number of participants. Marian Pilgrimages USA tours have been designed to accommodate individuals as well as groups. Times listed in itineraries are approximate and meant only as guidelines. Some itineraries may have early morning start times for sightseeing in order to complete the touring during daylight hours or avoid afternoon heat in hot climates. It is your responsibility to arrive on time for all scheduled flights, cruises, and package components. Persons requiring any assistance or who have any form of disability should refer to section "Travelers With Disabilities". On dates including, but not limited to religious holidays and national celebrations, some monuments and sites may be closed. On these occasions, touring itineraries may be amended to reflect these closures. Occasionally, during holidays and certain periods, and/or due to unforeseen circumstances including weather conditions there may be last-minute changes, sometimes after arrival, in affecting the sequence of the tour, locations visited and/or hotels. Therefore, we reserve the right to adjust the sequence and/or substitute any hotels with others of similar category. In such cases there will be no cost adjustment. National monuments and tourist sites regularly undergo renovations, which can obscure the monument's view. No tour will be canceled due to renovations; however Marian Pilgrimages USA will decide based on the conditions whether to amend an itinerary. Marian Pilgrimages USA itineraries may contain suggestions for activities for your leisure time; these suggestions do not constitute an endorsement of any specific service provider and the decision to participate in any such activities should be made independently and with due consideration.

Optional Sightseeing Tours: On occasion some itineraries will have optional tours, these will be available for purchase locally based upon availability. Some optional tours require a minimum number of participants and may not be operated; in such cases, the tour company will attempt to notify you locally. Optional tours may be conducted in more than one language.

Non-Operation of Escorted Tour: Escorted tour packages are based upon a minimum number of participants. Cancellation of any tour for lack of participation will be advised at least 45 days prior to the tour's departure, and all money will be refunded. Voluntary cancellations due to political instability, acts of terrorism, government intervention or US State Department warning will be subject to the above fees, provided the program is deemed (by Marian Pilgrimages USA) able to continue. This determination by Marian Pilgrimages USA will be based on the US State Department declaring it unsafe for US citizens to travel to areas that will directly affect a pilgrimage. In this case Marian Pilgrimages will endeavor to accommodate pilgrims on another pilgrimage or we will reschedule the pilgrimage to a time in the future at no extra cost. Any cancellation under these conditions will not be eligible for refund.

Group Harmony: To ensure the desired group synergy, Marian Pilgrimages USA reserves the right to accept, reject or expel any individual who is deemed disruptive or incompatible with the interests of the group. All expenses to do so will be borne by the passenger.

Health Requirements: Check with your healthcare provider for up-to-date requirements. You may also check the Centers for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) and/or the World Health Organization (<http://www.who.int/en/>) for their recommendations. Required inoculations, if any, must be recorded by clients' health practitioner on a valid vaccination certificate which the client must carry for proof of inoculation where required.
