Ways to Welcome Those from Diverse Backgrounds

- 1. Publish your bulletin announcements in the language of the different ethnic communities of your parish.
- 2. Reach out to the women of nearby parishes who do not have an affiliation and invite them to join yours.
- 3. Invite women from other parishes to participate in your activities.
- 4. If you have a college in your community or nearby, ask if there is a way to interact with the Catholic students there (Invite them to your events, attend their Campus Mass, send them care packages complete with a prayer card during finals...)
- 5. Ensure that your facility is welcoming and accommodating to people with disabilities.
- 6. Offer ride sharing for those members who are older and are not comfortable driving at night.
- 7. Promote activities from other groups in your parish and support them by your attendance.
- 8. Attend liturgies in other languages individually or as a group. Here is a link to where in the Orlando Diocese you can find such liturgies:
